Title: Executive Officer Report

SUMMARY

This report provides the Board, PEBP members and other stakeholders with information on agency operations.

REPORT

HPN Premium Reduction Update

The HPN – Medical Loss Ratio reduction in premium was voted on by the board to be applied in December. In addressing errors in premium reduction from December and January, PEBP decided to delay the additional interest owed to these members through premium reduction in February, and the adjustment will apply during the second pay period in April 2026. PEBP will owe additional interest from February to April. The total remaining interest to be reduced from member premiums should be \$3 per member. 3,213 members expected to receive the reduction in premium.

Open Meeting Law Complaint

After last month's board meeting, staff received a complaint that if PEBP were no longer producing transcription notes from a court reporter, then our meeting minutes were in violation of Nevada's Open Meeting Laws. Our in-house counsel, Brandee Mooneyhan, communicated this public concern with our Deputy Attorney General, and PEBP was notified that we are in compliance with our live-stream recording and publication via YouTube and with our meeting minutes. It was communicated that if PEBP wished to provide a transcription of future meetings that would be providing more than what is required to satisfy the requirements under statute. I have asked staff to generate the transcription from the YouTube site and add that with future meeting minutes for consumption. PEBP will not be hiring transcription services as that cost is not a requirement to meet statute.

Quality Control Officer Position

The position was posted for a two-week period. Personnel has notified us there are 28 applications for review. Staff will be reviewing those in the coming weeks and scheduling interviews.
